Job Description

P-19 Spiritual Development Programs Assistant (2 Openings) ***Peru***

Summary:

Will assist local community churches in their efforts to promote and implement prayer cell groups and couples' clubs. Will communicate Food for the Hungry's (FH) Vision of a Community (VOC) to church pastors and leaders. Will motivate and minister to the FH Hunger Corps Staff (HCS).

Qualifications:

Prefer a married couple with a background in theological studies and work among interdenominational churches. Prefer previous knowledge and experience in marriage and family counseling / orientation. Must be a good facilitator, with oral and teaching skills, the ability to strategize, plan and implement plus computer skills are required.

Duties:

1. Assist Project Coordinator in training pastors and leaders in management of prayer cells and couples' clubs
2. In collaboration with church leadership nurture, motivate and do follow-up to prayer cells and couples' clubs which have been initiated by the local churches. Many opportunities to build relationships.
3. Assist local churches in providing orientation and marriage/family counseling to the couples in whose homes the above prayer cells and couples' clubs meetings take place
4. As the occasion arises, provide family orientation talks to other organized community groups, such as teenagers in school, mothers' clubs, etc.
5. Participate with and support special activities such as VBS, Christmas, etc., which FH Project Promoters carry out with the support of local community churches
6. To run retreats twice a year for HCS and to regularly keep in touch and motivate them
7. As God leads, to network with other national and foreign missions, churches, and Bible Institutes to share about Vision of a Community principle and Worldview
8. In coordination with other Food for the Hungry International (FHI) project staff evaluate twice a year the spiritual progress that can be sensed -- has been made in the Child Sponsorship Program communities
