These last 13 months have been difficult but were made so much easier through your constant encouragement towards us. I (Paul) am down to part-time in Indianapolis and Megan has been done since June. Living out of a suitcase is all its cracked up to be as we have stored the "earthly possessions" we're not taking. Our free time is spent finalizing our plans such as our international drivers licenses, vaccinations and attempting to plan our lifestyle for the next three years.

The next few weeks will be spent slowing down our life in anticipation for a radically different way of life in Peru. If you noticed on the left, we have that as a prayer request for us. We've been told by pretty much everyone that we'll have to slow way down to adjust to the relational culture. We are excited about this but know it will be challenging. Learning Spanish is part of the cultural adjustment too. Our ministries' effectiveness will be dependent on our ability to communicate with those we are around, therefore this is a top priority for us in language school for the next three or four months and beyond in Pucallpa.
