We put our house on the market on Wednesday, April 25, and we wrote up a contract for it on April 28! WE NEED A PLACE TO LIVE BY MAY 25th! It all happened so fast and our internet was having problems, so we couldn't tell you about it. How frustrating! This is actually the third version of this newsletter because things kept happening, and then our Internet went down. First of all, days after our last newsletter, we found a school for the boys in Lima, Peru, and had to increase our monthly budget by just a little bit. Having to increase our budget discouraged us greatly, but then we saw that God was bringing people to this ministry team fast enough to cover the need...and then go beyond. We now feel affirmed in our decision for the boys and confident in what the Lord is doing!



After we finalized the budget, we started getting ready to sell our house. We had a couple of young women from our church look at it. Thankfully it didn't work out for them to buy it because we realized that we didn't have the first clue about selling a house. A friend recommended Melissa Kyzer from Russell and Jeffcoat—she's awesome and we highly recommend her. We spent two solid weeks, working from 8:30pm-1am every night, getting our house ready to sell. It was wild and crazy, rather stressful, and somewhat exhausting, but we did it, and we had a quick sale to show for it.

SOOOO...If we are going to pull up roots, we need a place to go—we'd like that place to be Lima, Peru! But, since we will have gap between the sale of our home and our departure, we are looking for a place to live until our ministry team is complete. Please let us know if you have any suggestions! Our closing date is May 25th!!

Thank you to those who have increased your commitments, made new commitments, and/or given one time special gifts! We're getting there! Just like it's toughest to lose that last 10 pounds, it can be just as tough to raise that last 10%. Please pray for us as we seek God's completion for this Ministry Team!
